

Vincent SUBILIA (born in 1975)

Deputy Director of the Geneva Chamber of Commerce in charge of International Affairs, Vincent Subilia joined the Chamber in 2015, in line with his previous assignment as Economic Development Officer of the State of Geneva; among his responsibilities, Vincent is in charge of overseeing the arbitration and mediation services provided by this Institution.

A qualified lawyer with robust expertise gained in Switzerland and abroad (including in Brussels, London, New York and Beijing), Vincent worked within a large international bank in Geneva as Vice President for numerous years, as well as for a major law firm specialised in WTO issues.

An alumni of the Graduate Institute of Geneva, Vincent is politically involved as municipal councillor of the City of Geneva. He further acts as the President of AGIR, an association which he founded in 2009, to advocate the assets of the "international Geneva"; in this respect, Vincent has been recently appointed as vice-President of the newly created Rotary Club Genève International.
